**Bachelor of Laws (Honours):** 17 common core units (102 credit points) + 15 law elective units (90 credit points) including **one** commercial law elective and **one** research project unit + 2 non-law electives (12 credit points) = **Total of 204 points.**

- The map assumes a student has been granted credit for 36 points (6 units) based on prior tertiary studies in another discipline and has 168 credit points (28 law units) to complete.
- Subject to approval, a student may elect to finish in 3 years by taking a 6 credit point overload in four semesters.
