This means we can now move on with finalising the protocol, working through the logistics and continuing to develop the database (including inventory) and finer details of study conduct.

Even though our plans for start up are delayed on the original estimates we aim to conduct start up meetings at the end of 2015 with recruitment starting early in 2016.
