

Australian National Diabetes Audit (ANDA)



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ANDA is a national clinical quality registry aiming to improve the quality of care provided to patients attending health care services (diabetes centres) for management of diabetes. ANDA collects data about patients' diabetes treatments, complications, self-care practices and quality of life outcomes. This information is used to help determine what factors contribute and promote better patient care and outcomes.

ANDA aims to provide a diabetes dataset aligned with national reporting guidelines and standards of care, identify areas of excellence and opportunities for improvement as well as facilitate development of procedures, clinical guidelines and policies.

A placement with ANDA offers the opportunity to contribute to this vital study and join our team of clinicians, biostatisticians, project management, data management, researchers and PhD students.

You will take part in a variety of research tasks such as reviewing literature, data entry and validation, data analysis and interpretation, assisting with reporting and publications.
