

FEE INFORMATION AND CENSUS DATES

The Bachelor of Medical Science (Honours) degree (Course Code M3701) is a full year program. Students will be enrolled in full-year units that run from either:

- January to November (Full-year extended: Teaching period FY32), or
- July to May the following year (Mid-year intake: Teaching period S2-S1-02)

The census date (the last date you can withdraw from a subject without being financially liable) is listed on the enrolments page — ensure you are looking at the correct teaching period.

Note that if you discontinue the course or take an intermission after the census date, you will not be eligible for a refund of fees unless special circumstances apply; refer to the <u>refund policy</u>.

PAYMENT PLANS FOR INTERNATIONAL AND FULL-FEE PAYING DOMESTIC STUDENTS

A payment plan is available for international and domestic <u>full-fee paying</u> students enrolled in these courses. This will allow you to pay your tuition fees in two (occasionally three) instalments: Refer to the <u>Fees webpage</u> for the payment dates relevant to your teaching period.

These dates will appear on your fees statement once you have applied and been approved for the fee payment plan. You should apply as soon as possible and prior to the payment due date on your fees statement each year.
