 - Currently, you studies have focused on "how" things are done
 - Question current practice and potentially recommend changes
 - Think critically



Why do honours?

- Enhance future career opportunities in industry, practice and academia
- Advanced knowledge of higher-level accounting issues
- Develop a variety of skills:
 - Problem-solving and analytical;
 - Communication;
 - Research and empirical; and


