Intellectual Property and Ethics

The Intellectual Property and Ethical Research form must be completed by all graduate research students.

If you are a new student and are required to assign your Intellectual Property (IP) to the University, you will be unable to progress your enrolment until you have submitted the Student Assignment Deed.

Monash offers free legal advice to students via the Monash Graduate Association (MGA). If you have any questions about the legal implications of this form and/or how this form affects your rights, contact the MGA.

It's important that you speak to your supervisors about IP at least annually, and when a change to your research project has occurred that may impact on your intellectual property obligations.

You can refer to the <u>Guidelines on Graduate Research Student Intellectual Property</u> to help you understand what this means.

Please note that if Intellectual Property assigned under a Student Assignment Deed is commercialised by the University, the net revenue received by the University will be shared with you as a student according to the University policy made under Regulations 24(9) of the Monash University (Vice-Chancellor) Regulations.

Ethics and Compliance
