Course requirements

Total credit points: 204 cp (all units are 6 cp unless otherwise specified)

1. ***Overload:** To complete the course in 4 years, students are required to overload in year 2 by two units (EDF2088, EDF2099).
 - Students who do not wish to overload in both semesters in year 2 can opt to:
 - a. complete both units during the summer semester at Clayton campus, or
 - b. overload by one unit in year 2 and take one unit in the summer semester at Clayton campus.
 - Students who choose not to overload or study in the summer semester, will extend the duration of their course.
2. **First-year requirement:** National Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students. The Faculty of Education's [LANTITE page](#) has more information on this test.

Core studies	Seven units/42 cp
Education studies	Eight units/48 cp ▪ Students complete a 6 cp elective unit. You can select a level 2 or 3 unit from across the university in which you are eligible to enrol. You can also select from a range of flagship rich educational experiences (FREE), including the Monash Innovation Guarantee (MIG), Research, Experimentation and Discovery (RED) or volunteering. These FREE units may be credited in place of your free elective if approved by the faculty. ▪ You must discuss your eligibility with your Education Success Adviser (ESA) prior to enrolling in FREE.
Curriculum studies	Thirteen units/78 cp ▪ Students complete two secondary method units (EDF51XX) in the discipline area in which they are specialising.
Discipline studies	Six units/36 cp ▪ Students complete a six-unit discipline study, chosen from the discipline studies list, which comprises six units in an elected discipline with at least 12 cp each at levels 2 and 3. ▪ If you have entered the course via the Diploma of Higher Education you complete only four units in the discipline area.
Professional experience	▪ Six professional experience units/80 days of supervised professional experience in primary and secondary schools. ▪ Students must complete professional experience orientation provided by the faculty prior to undertaking any professional experience. International students please note: ▪ International students who wish to meet current AITSL skill assessment requirements for secondary teachers must complete EDF3083 Secondary professional experience 3D in place of EDF3082 Secondary professional experience 3A. ▪ EDF3083 provides the required 10 days of professional experience to meet course requirements, plus an additional 5 days of professional experience in a secondary setting, totalling 15 days of placement. ▪ Students are advised to independently check AITSL skill assessment requirements.
