Requirements for the Bachelor of Learning Design and Technology

Total credit points: 144 cp

Campus: Education and IT core units are undertaken at Clayton; MADA core units are undertaken at Caulfield; elective units may be taken across different campuses.

Optional elective in Part D: Students may wish to apply to enrol in the [Monash Innovation Guarantee \(MIG\)](#). MIG is equal to one 6 cp elective unit and may be selected in either second or third year (full time students), or fourth year (part time students). Students must have completed a minimum 24 cp of level one study to be eligible to apply. Available as a summer B enrolment.

You must discuss your eligibility with your Education Success Adviser (ESA) prior to enrolling in MIG.

Themes

A. Core studies: eleven units/66 cp

B. Specialist studies: six units/36 cp

C. Professional practice: two units/12 cp

D. Elective studies: from the following elective unit selections, you must complete 30 cp of which no more than 12 cp are at level 1. Some units may have enrolment rules such as pre-requisites and you may need permission from the owning faculty to enrol in some units taught by other faculties.

If you wish to pursue an alternative elective unit, you will need to consult with your Education Success Advisor (ESA).
