## **Student Compliance Check List**

There are a number of actions that you need to complete as a Monash student enrolled in a course with placement requirements. These are necessary for you to demonstrate that you can practice safely in the Australian health care system.

The process of meeting the mandatory requirements does take time to complete so it is a good idea to start as soon as possible. The check list below is to help you work through the requirements

Getting Started	
	Read through any mandatory information and documents provided to you
	Read with understanding the <u>Student Placement Guide</u>
	Gather together all your childhood immunisation documentation
Doctor appointments	
	Make an appointment with a doctor ( <u>University Health Services</u> , <u>Monash Infection Assessment Clinic</u> or GP)
	Make sure you take all your immunisation records to the doctor's appointment
	Make sure you take <u>FORM 1 immunisation compliance</u> with you to your doctor's appointment
	Identify follow up appointments for vaccinations and results and take FORM 1 with you
	Ask your doctor to provide you with the serology results identified on FORM 1
	Check that you doctor signs, dates and stamps FORM 1 when it is completed
	Make sure you know when you need to have a flu vaccine and have FORM 2 completed

	Apply for an international criminal history check (check if required)
	Apply for a National Police Check as directed in your documentation
	Apply for a Working with Children Check as directed in your documentation
	Apply for an NDIS Check as directed in your documentation
And finally	
	Complete any extra preparation for placement requirements for your course
