### PROFESSOR TINA BROCK

Director Pharmacy Education  
Faculty of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences, Monash University

Professor Tina Brock joined the faculty earlier this year. A clinical pharmacist, with additional training in educational systems and social/behavioural sciences, Professor Brock is an internationally renowned education innovator. Her experience working on an international scale and her passion for collaboration provide a fine example for our students.

Professor Brock is proud to be the first to have worked at all three PharmAlliance member institutes: Monash University, University College London and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

She has previously served as the Associate Dean for Global Health and Educational Innovations at the University of California, San Francisco School of Pharmacy; the Director of Capacity Building and Performance Improvement at Management Sciences for Health; the Course Director for the MSc in Pharmacy Practice and Policy at University College London; and the Director of Student Services at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Eshelman School of Pharmacy.

A collaborator, Professor Brock does her best work as part of an empowered team. Fittingly she has an interest in inter-professional education and is excited by what graduates who have been trained to work in inter-professional teams can achieve.

### DR SOON-EE CHEAH

Mollie Holman Doctoral Medal

The increasing incidence of infections caused by Gram-negative 'superbugs' is emerging as one of the most significant threats confronting public health in the modern era. Dr Soon-Ee Cheah's PhD combined *in vitro* experimental models, mathematical modeling and high-throughput sequencing to characterise polymixin activity against Gram-negative 'superbug' *A. baumannii*. His thesis demonstrates the utility of combining *in vitro* and *in silico* strategies for investigating antimicrobial pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics.



### JACK LUKE JANETZKI

Monash Pharmacy Internship Prize

Jack completed his internship at Nhill Pharmacy in western Victoria, where he now works as a community pharmacist. He is motivated by the expansion of professional services within the pharmacy and is completing his Graduate Certificate in Pharmacy Practice at Monash.
