Course requirements

1. **Total credit points:** 204 cp (all units are 6 cp unless otherwise specified)
2. ***Overload:** To complete the course in 4 years, students are required to overload in year 2 by two units (EDF2088, EDF2099).
 - Students who do not wish to overload in both semesters in year 2 can opt to:
 - a. complete both units during the summer semester at Clayton campus, or
 - b. overload by one unit in year 2 and take one unit in the summer semester at Clayton campus.
 - Students who choose not to overload or study in the summer semester, will extend the duration of their course.
3. **First-year requirement:** National Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students. The Faculty of Education's [LANTITE page](#) has more information on this test.

Education studies	Eleven units/66 cp ▪ Students complete a 6 cp elective unit. You can select a level 2 or 3 unit from across the university in which you are eligible to enrol. You can also select from a range of flagship rich educational experiences (FREE), including the Monash Innovation Guarantee (MIG), Research, Experimentation and Discovery (RED) or volunteering. These FREE units may be credited in place of your free elective if approved by the faculty. ▪ You must discuss your eligibility with your Education Success Adviser (ESA) prior to enrolling in FREE.
