Notes

- On commencing the course and prior to commencing placement, students must obtain provisional registration with the [Psychology Board of Australia](#). This registration must be maintained for the duration of the course.
- All students are required to complete a practice log. Accumulated hours are resulted when students enrol into EDF5572*.
- In Year 2 (full-time) or Years 3 and 4 (part-time), students complete two supervised clinical placements and complete a research thesis on a topic relevant to the discipline of educational and developmental psychology.

Professional Experience:

- Students must complete professional experience orientation provided by the faculty prior to undertaking any professional experience.
- *Placement activities are undertaken in conjunction with coursework units.
- Some days and hours may be transferred between the two clinical placement units with **the prior written permission of the Chief examiner of the final placement unit EDF5733**.
