Virtual Internships as a Requirement (VWIL)

- VWIL allows students to <u>remotely connect</u> and <u>collaborate</u> with your organisation and we provide ongoing support to you and the student throughout the placement
- We request that if you are choosing to host a student onsite, that there is a <u>back-up plan to host them virtually</u> in case a situation arises where they cannot work in the office


