Requirements for the Master of Teaching in Primary and Secondary Education

Total credit points – 96 points

1. Compulsory units – sixteen units/96 points

2. Professional experience units – four units/60 days of satisfactory professional experience
Students must complete a compulsory orientation before undertaking any professional experience.

3. First-year requirement: National Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (see the [Handbook](#) for details)

4. Primary specialist sequence: Students complete one of the following Primary specialist sequences:

English and literacy

- EDF5831 Primary English 2
- EDF5852 Leading English and literacy in primary schools

Mathematics and numeracy

- EDF5832 Primary mathematics 2
- EDF5853 Leading mathematics and numeracy in primary schools

5. Skilled migration requirements: Students who need to meet AITSL skilled migration requirements for secondary teachers must complete [EDF5895](#). All other students must complete [EDF5894](#).
