The workshop is part of *Making Space*, a suite of inspirational hands-on workshops in the galleries alongside artworks from the Monash University Collection presented in the exhibition *Connecting the World through Sculpture*. This exhibition, celebrating sixty years of the Collection, will take place in one half of the Museum in three parts: *From the Ground Up* (7–24 July), *The Sculptural Body* (31 July – 20 August) and *Up in the Air* (28 August – 18 September).
