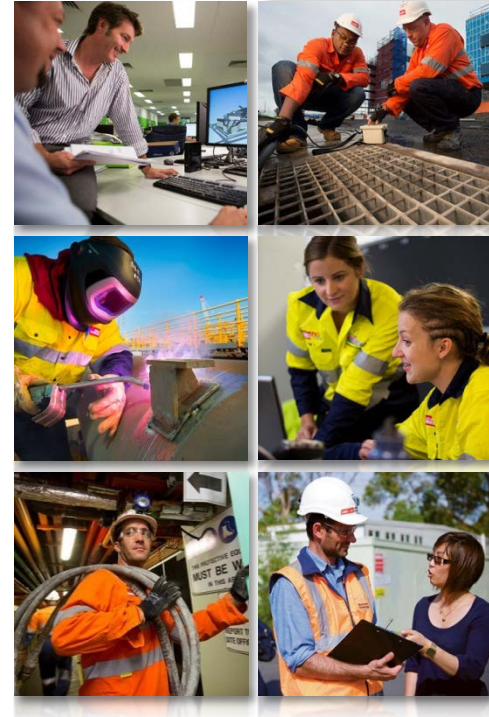

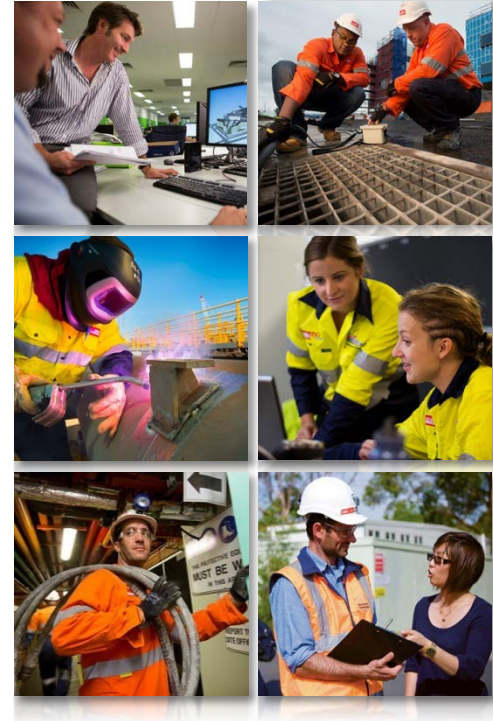
There is much to be done
