ASSESSMENT

Registrants will be required to complete a GP Clinical Radiography Record Book and practical decision-making exercises after the workshop. In addition, registrants will sit a short open-book exam prior to completion of the course. NB: Assessment will be completed off-campus, in your home region.

MATERIALS

- course notes divided into seven modules (online);
- radiographic images (online);
- radiographic anatomy and pathology images (online);
- the GP Clinical Radiography Record Book (online); and the textbook *Accident and Emergency Radiology: A Survival Guide* by Nigel Raby, Laurence Berman, Gerald de Lacey, Elsevier.

PROFESSIONAL RECOGNITION

Our course is:

- recognised for the purpose of awarding Use Licence for general practitioners in Victoria;
- recognised by the Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine (ACRRM) for QA and CME and;
- recognised by the RACGP for CPD points and a two-day grant in emergency medicine.

ADMISSION CRITERIA AND FEES

Course fees: A\$2800

Applicants must be general practitioners practicing in rural areas with an RRMA two to seven.

General practitioners in RRMA three to seven, Victoria, can apply for a registration fee subsidy through the Department of Human Services. This will be a 50% or 70% subsidy depending on whether there is support from the local health service or division. Click [here](#) for more information.
