Throughout term three we invite you to visit MUMA for *Making Space*, a suite of inspirational hands-on workshops. In August join Singaporean Australian sculptor Nabilah Nordin for an inspirational opportunity to let your students' imaginations run wild as they learn about form, colour and playfully bringing found objects and materials together. They will respond to Nordin's immersive, ever-expanding sculptural vocabulary, celebrating seductive surfaces and exploring the anthropomorphic qualities of materials.

In a unique setting, students will learn in the galleries alongside artworks from the Monash University Collection presented in the exhibition *Connecting the World through Sculpture*. This exhibition, celebrating sixty years of the Collection, will take place in one half of the Museum in three parts: *From the Ground Up* (7–24 July), *The Sculptural Body* (31 July – 20 August) and *Up in the Air* (28 August – 18 September). This is an incredible opportunity for students to explore creative practice and thinking in close proximity to the Monash University Collection.
