SERVICES ON CAMPUS

- 1 Student Services Monash Connect**
Not sure where to start to access the help you need? The friendly staff at the Monash Connect helpdesk in Building 401 can point you in the right direction.

- 2 24 hour security desk 9903 9999 / 9905 3333 in an emergency**
Security in Building 404 are always around. They can walk you to your car late at night or provide first aid in case of an accident. Also speak to them if you experience any building access issues.
- 3 Charge your device stations**
Got a laptop or phone that needs some juice? Inside and outside the Library you'll find some secure charging stations. Most other social and study spaces also have access to power points.
- 4 Vending Machines**
You can find the vending machines across from the library next to the lift. A wide variety of snacks and drinks are available for purchase.
- 5 Microwaves and drink taps**
Heat up your lunch or fill up your water bottle here. Hot water is also available. You can also refill your drink bottle at the fountain in the Cossar Hall Courtyard.

- 6 Peer Academic Support Services (PASS Program)**
Some of the units you'll study here can be tough. That's why we run PASS classes, which involve senior students providing academic support. To sign up, keep an eye on Moodle—registrations are generally open in weeks 2–3 of semester. If you have any questions about PASS, visit Monash Connect.
- 7 Monash Parkville Student Union (MPSU) Office**
If you want to know about Parkville's busy student social life or link in with our clubs and societies, visit the MPSU office next to the student common room.
- 8 Senior Student Experience Officer**
On the ground floor of Building 404 opposite the lifts/security desk in the Marketing Office works the Senior Student Experience Officer. They facilitate a number of student social and leadership activities for students. Take the time to go and introduce yourself or contact them at parkville.studentexperience@monash.edu
- 9 Group Fitness**

SPACES ON CAMPUS

- 1 The CL Butchers Library**
Our library holds the largest collection of pharmaceutical books in the southern hemisphere, and the expert team can help you find relevant resources and assist with your learning. During semester the library is open until 7pm most weekdays, and outside of semester it closes at 5pm. For full opening hours, visit: monash.edu/pharm/library
- 2 24hr Study Space**
Room G.05 is a 24-hour study space, allowing those of you who are night owls to study flexibly and safely. Have your student card activated for 24 hour access at the security desk.
- 3 Student Cafeteria**
A great place to meet, eat and relax. Look out for timely announcements on the big screen.
- 4 Student Common Room**
Chill out with your friends between classes in the student common room. There's pool tables, table tennis, TV screens, a piano and a sound system.
- 5 Quiet study spaces**
There are a number of quiet study spaces dotted around campus—you just have to find them! Seek out the Professional Practice Suites on Level 1 of the Scott Building, the quiet study carrels in the library and the sneaky desk under the Scott Building stairs!
- 6 Sports court**
In the front of the Manning Building is a multi-purpose sports court. Sports equipment can be borrowed from the Monash Connect help desk—you just need to trade in your ID card.
- 7 The Deck**
The decked area between the Scott and Manning Buildings is a great place to relax on a nice day. Hint: push the green button to gain entry!
- 8 Pharmacy practice building**
You won't have any classes here but you may need to visit a lecturer who has an office here, although many lecturers are located in other buildings. Building 407 is also home to the StEPs Office, who are responsible for all pharmacy student placements.
- 9 Flipboard**
Home to the most convenient coffee and hot chocolates on campus. Also a great space to meet friends and study.
