Students are advised to:

- First undertake the foundational units (PSY4111 and PSY4122) in any order.

- Next, undertake **intermediate units** (PSY4131 and PSY4051) in any order.

 - Note PSY4151 is an intermediate unit, but not a pre-requisite for any further units.
- The **advanced units** are PSY4041, PSY4081, PSY4032 and PSY4062.
