A Graduate Entry Pathway is available to successful applicants with a completed relevant degree. Credit is granted upon successful completion of PHR1001 Bridge to practice 1 (12cp); an overload unit, PHR1101 Bridge to practice 2 (6cp) is required when commencing in Year 3 of the course.

Pre-requisites: There is a pass by year rule in Year 1 of this course. There is a pass by semester rule from Year 2 of this course. In order to progress in Year 4 students must have completed all prior placements.
